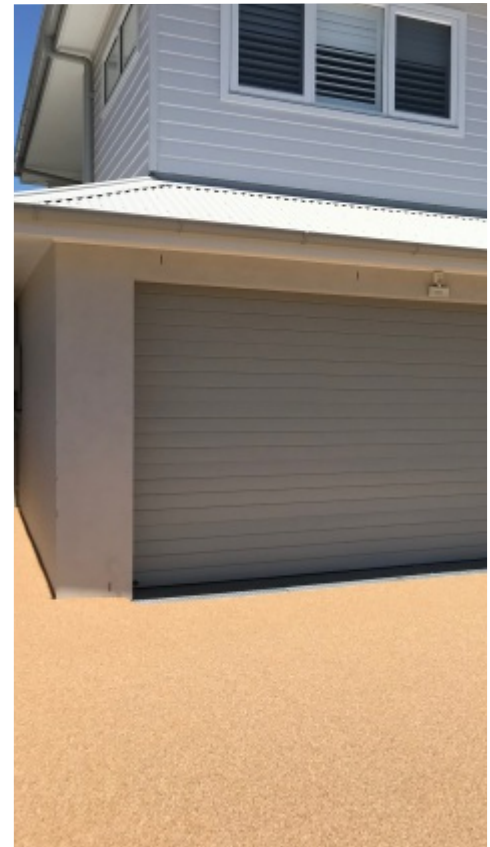

### High Contrast Two Tone Driveway

Stone - 6mm Pitch Black with 3mm Bundaberg Pearl

Cost - \$140/sqm (approx. at 100sqm)

Nothing drives attention like bold contrast. Here, the clean lined union of Pitch Black and Bundaberg Pearl coexist like yin and yang as the feature canvas in this modern and elegant design piece.

Shaped by equidistant black crescents, StoneSet formed two complimentary sweeping curves, which act to channel the visual space with a central off-white pearl as one large inviting swept movement flowing to and from the family home.

The driveways' slope proved pitch-perfect, presenting like a canvas to the urban space in a very elegant statement of form and function. The off white being channelled away from adjacent garden beds where the risk of occasional dirt and debris would be buffered by the darker coloured stone

All in all, one of Sydney's most modern additions to the urban streetscape. Innovative modern flair offsetting a more traditional facade of neutral creams, generous archways and American bay windows.

Overlay existing paved surface  
Stone - 6mm Beach at 16mm depth  
Cost - \$110/sqm (approx. at 200+sqm)

Blessed with palms and a sun drenched rear courtyard these homeowners were inspired to create a tropical oasis in their own back yard.

The warm yellow tone of this blend of Beach stone formed a bright natural harmony with the property's beige exterior. Unifying the property's surrounds, from the moment you enter the driveway, to the time you retreat to the pool.



Here, porous stone paving was also a practical choice. Resin bound stone created a porous hard surface with no loose stone. Together with small amounts of vegetation they created a functional low maintenance yard.

Rainwater could permeate through to support the palms and surrounding vegetation, like sand on a beach.

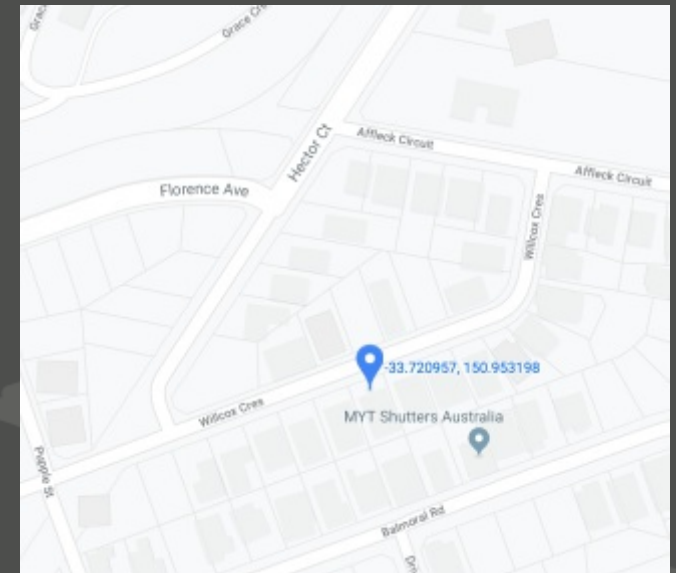




“Resin bound stone is unique amongst paving products in that, unlike segmental pavers, it can be shaped with the aid of aluminum edging.”

This gives way to divine flowing curves and patterns that break all the rules of decorative driveway paving.

The malleable nature of resin bound stone set it apart as truly modern compared to the traditional herringbone or 45 degree angle highlights and borders of the 1980s







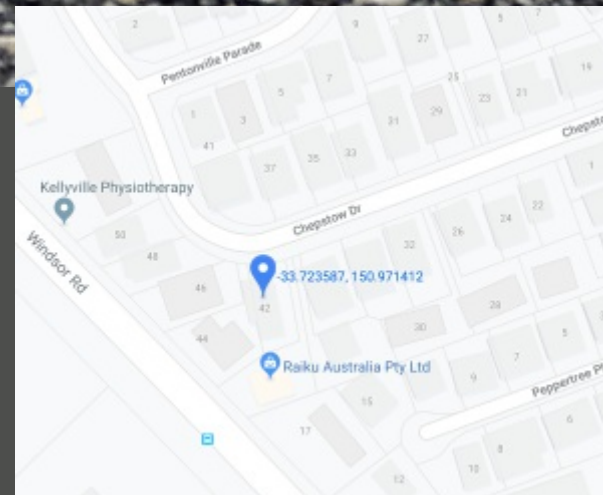

Overlay large concrete driveway  
Stone - 6mm Charcoal Harvest at 16mm depth  
Cost - \$110/sqm (approx. at 180sqm)

With the increase in the cost of land, large concrete driveways have become more prevalent, on battle axe and subdivided blocks, strata title apartments and townhouse communities. Over the years these driveways can become cracked and are patched up, without losing their structural integrity.

Resin bound stone is the perfect disorder - meets order appearance.

Natural stone paving has been used historically for millenia. This is one reason StoneSet has been used to pave iconic heritage listed locations such as Sydney Observatory, Kirribilli House and Port Arthur

Modern day liabilities of these sites means loose stone is not safe nor tolerable, nor practical for say young and elderly visitors.

However binding the stone with resin brings order to disorder. All the benefits of a natural and traditional appearance, maintaining the true heritage value of a

property but making it safe and slip free.

By using a smaller size 3mm stone, StoneSet can be used where people don't wear shoes - for pool surrounds and even inside - the perfect natural stone carpet, which is also porous, meaning non slip for internal shower areas, garages and carports and pool surrounds.
